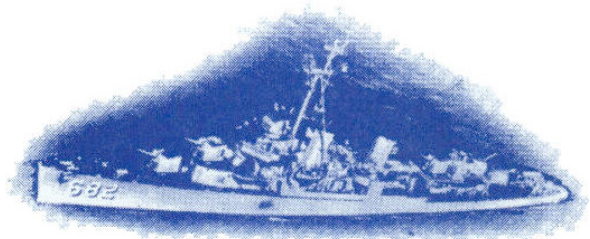
The plan is to attend the Memorial Day Ceremony at the Nimitz Memorial.
